

Columbia Swimming League Scholarship For 2008



APPLICATION PROCEDURE

Applicant must:

1. Complete the enclosed application (A), Volunteer/Service/Activity Sheet (B1, B2) and CSL Team & League Contribution Form (C).

Upon completion, mail to the address below

2. Give your principal or guidance counselor the Nomination Form (D). Ask to have them filled out, attached to your transcript with a letter of recommendation and send to the address below.
3. Give a Community Leader Reference Form (E) to a member of the community that knows you well & can write on your behalf. Ask them to fill out form and send to the address below.
4. Give the CSL Coach Input Sheet (F) to your coach. Your Coach will complete & mail to the address below.
5. Give the League Rep Input Sheet (G) to your league rep. The League rep will complete & mail to the address below.

In a case where the coach & the rep are the same person or only one is familiar with the applicant, you may submit G & Omit F.

QUALIFICATIONS/ELIGIBILITY

1. The applicant must be in the class of 2008 or 2009 from an accredited high school.
2. The applicant must have the recommendation of his/her principal or guidance counselor.
3. The applicant must have the recommendation of a community leader.
4. The applicant must have the recommendation of their league rep.
5. A scholarship recipient must attend an accredited college, university, or technical school in the United States.
6. The applicant must be of good moral character and reputation.
7. The applicant must have a least 3.0 on a 4.0 grading scale.
8. The applicant must have participated in CSL for 3 years (*this may be reduced to the number of years a team has been in the league if less than 3*) and be an active member of the CSL this year.

METHOD OF SELECTION

1. The scholarship committee consists of 5 league members selected by the Columbia Swimming League Board. This committee will select At Least one male & one female who has best represented the Columbia Swimming League by the example of leadership to younger swimmers, without regard to applicant's swimming ability.
2. Weights:

Contribution to CSL	50%
Scholastic	25%
Contribution to community	25%
3. Finalists may be interviewed by the Scholarship Committee to determine the winner.
